MEMORANDUM FOR 1-62nd ADA Battalion Soldiers and Civilians

SUBJECT: Command Policy Letter #8, Barracks Alcohol

1. The glamorization and excessive use of alcohol is prejudicial to unit good order and discipline. Lives are unnecessarily placed at risk when alcohol induced decision making is employed.
2. Each Soldier is authorized up to one six pack (consumed or unopened) and one fifth of a bottle of hard liquor in their barracks room. For rooms that have two assigned occupants, each Soldier is authorized the above amount.
3. Punitive Order: Soldiers who violate this policy may be subject to adverse administrative action and / or punishment under the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ).
4. Post this policy on unit bulletin boards and ensure it is understood by every member of this command.
