

MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Command Safety Policy

1. **PURPOSE.** To establish safety guidance within the 13th Corps Support Command.
2. **APPLICABILITY.** Headquarters, 13th Corps Support Command and all subordinate units.
3. **BACKGROUND.** Commanders within the COSCOM will establish safety and risk assessments as priorities. Safety is both an individual and command responsibility.
4. **POLICY.** Commanders will provide an environment where all Soldiers are empowered to stop any unsafe act. First-Line leaders are accountable for ensuring a safe environment and a safety-conscious mindset for their soldiers. Composite Risk management will be integrated into the planning and execution of all on-duty training, mission activities, and unit social events; off duty for holiday weekends and traveling while on leave. We must employ our leadership strengths to sustain our safety awareness and keep safety on the minds of every soldier and leader! Safety is a commander's program with all leaders sharing the responsibility of maintaining a safe environment.
5. **EXPIRATION.** This policy will remain in effect until superseded or rescinded.
