Subject: Government Quarters Not Available at Group A Privatization of Army Lodging (PAL) Installations

1. On 15 August 2009, Army Lodging operations at ten installations were privatized under the auspices of the Military Housing Privatization Initiative, 10 U.S.C. §§2871, et seq.
2. Installations with privatized PAL Group A lodging include Fort Hood and Sam Houston Texas, Fort Sill, Oklahoma, Fort Polk, Louisiana, Fort Rucker, Alabama, Fort Riley and Leavenworth, Kansas, Fort Myer, Virginia, Yuma Proving Ground, Arizona, Tripler Army Medical Center-Fort Shafter, Hawaii.
3. As a result of privatization, these ten installations have been added to the Worldwide Listing of Army Installations without Official Travel Government Quarters. As a result, official travelers to PAL Group A installations will no longer be required to present Certificates or Statements of Non-Availability for reimbursement under the Joint Federal Travel Regulations.
