


PROVOST MARSHAL

 - **Off Post dial 911 for emergencies**
 - Motorcycle / Vehicle Registration – Bldg 23023, 287-9909
 - **Must have the following:**
 - 1. ID CARD or EMPLOYMENT LETTER**
 - 2. VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE**
 - 3. PROOF OF INSURANCE**
 - 4. VEHICLE REGISTRATION**
- * NOTE: MOTORCYCLE OPERATORS MUST HAVE VALID SAFETY CARD*



PROVOST MARSHAL



- Privately Owned Weapons Registration – Bldg 23023, 287-4403
 - **Properly fill out (FHT FORM 190-X19) and turn in to Civilian Police Liaison in Bldg 23023. Monday thru Friday 0900-1800**
 - **Forms may be turned in on Saturdays and Sundays to the MP Desk at Bldg 23020**
- **If you are entering post with your Weapon you must:**
 - **Declare possession of your weapon to the guards**
 - **Ensure that you have your (PINK COPY) of FHT FORM 190-X19 with you.**
 - **Ensure that the weapon and ammunition are stored in separate locations and that the weapon is not loaded.**


