





Summer Safety Campaign



Summer Safety Campaign

STAFF RESPONSIBILITIES

- Safety/PAO – disseminate/publish periodic summer safety info & articles in papers/flyers
- Staff – Review/update weather notification/emergency response Regs, emergency tests, safe on-post swim areas
- MEDDAC – Assist Cdrs with heat stress training, conduct aggressive health/welfare surveys



Summer Safety Campaign

COMMANDER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Develop unit-level summer safety programs**
- **Conduct day-long safety day**
- **Ensure POV safety programs are executed per CSA 6-point POV Safety Program**
- **Aviation units review, update & rehearse A/C tie down, security, & fly away procedures**
- **Appoint Heat Injury Control Officer/NCO to oversee heat stress program**



Summer Safety Campaign

COMMANDERS' RESPONSIBILITIES (cont)

- **Conduct initial heat stress training and monthly refresher training**
- **ID soldiers with previous heat injury**
- **Supply adequate water, nutritional intake**
- **Thoroughly investigate on- off-duty heat injuries, countermeasures for recurrences**
- **Company size elements monitor WBGT during training & other unit-sponsored events**



Summer Safety Campaign

OFF-DUTY & FAMILY SAFETY

- **Junior Ldrs assists soldiers with ID'ing hazards & provide controls for planned summer activities and POV travels**
- **PT/Running – Leaders educate soldiers on heat stress dangers, wear protective gear for ID**
- **Water sports – Leaders brief soldiers on standards & injury prevention measures**
- **Picnics, BBQs, Grass Cutting, Sunburn – To be emphasized**
