## LITTER OBSTACLE COURSE (LOC)

(FM 8-10-6, Chap 9 and Sec II)

### PERFORMANCE MEASURES

NOTE: The casualty will wear a helmet, protective mask in its carrier, load carrying equipment (LCE), and appropriate uniform. Mannequins will not be used.

- GO  NO GO      a. Negotiates the obstacle using the "low wall carry" (FM 8-10-6, figs 9-60 and 9-61).
- GO  NO GO      1. No. 1 man or woman issues appropriate commands, performs the no. 1 position tasks, and maintains control of the litter squad.
- GO  NO GO      2. No. 2 man or woman performs the no. 2 position tasks.
- GO  NO GO      3. No. 3 man or woman performs the no. 3 position tasks.
- GO  NO GO      4. No. 4 man or woman performs the no. 4 position tasks.
- GO  NO GO      b. Does not cause further injury to the casualty.

- GO  NO GO      2. High wall.
- GO  NO GO      a. Negotiates the obstacle using the "high wall carry" (FM 8-10-6, figs 9-62).
- GO  NO GO      1. No. 1 man or woman issues appropriate commands, performs the no. 1 position tasks, and maintains control of the litter squad.
- GO  NO GO      2. No. 2 man or woman performs the no. 2 position tasks.
- GO  NO GO      3. No. 3 man or woman performs the no. 3 position tasks.
- GO  NO GO      4. No. 4 man or woman performs the no. 4 position tasks.
- GO  NO GO      b. Does not cause further injury to the casualty.

NOTE: Candidates may help each other over the obstacle, if permitted by the no. 1 man or woman.

3. Narrow obstacle.

GO  NO GO

a. Negotiates the obstacle using the "two-man carry for narrow trails and passages" (FM 8-10-6, figs 9-55).

1. No. 1 man or woman issues appropriate commands, performs the no.1 position tasks, and maintains control of the litter squad.

2. No. 2 man or woman performs the no. 2 position tasks.

3. No. 3 man or woman performs the no. 3 position tasks.

4. No. 4 man or woman performs the no. 4 position tasks.

GO  NO GO

b. Does not cause further injury to the casualty.

GO  NO GO

4. Trench, excavation, or gully.

GO  NO GO

a. Negotiates the obstacle using the "Overhead carry" (FM 8-10-6, figs 9-64).

GO  NO GO

1. No.1 man or woman issues appropriate commands, and any supplementary instructions to place the two shorter squad members under the litter stirrups and maintains control of the litter squad.

GO  NO GO

2. No. 2 man or woman performs assigned tasks.

GO  NO GO

3. No. 3 man or woman performs assigned tasks.

GO  NO GO

4. No. 4 man or woman performs assigned tasks.

NOTE: This carry does not have specific places for the no. 1, no. 2, no. 3, or no. 4 man or woman. The no. 1 man or woman must direct the other squad members into position.

b. Does not cause further injury to the casualty.

5. Completes the course within the time limit (if a time is established by the test board).
