1. AR 385-55, 12 March 1987 is further supplemented as follows.

2. Page 7, paragraph 2-18, Safe tactical vehicle operation. Add subparagraph h.

h. Tracked vehicles will not move on/off post without a licensed driver and a track commander (TC). The driver and TC will ensure the intercom system is operable and wear the combat vehicle crewman (CVC) helmet at all times. The only exception to this is when vehicles are in congested areas (i.e., motor pools, at railheads, around bivouac areas). In these situations, a ground guide(s) will assist the driver in maneuvering the vehicle safely.
