**Units** Units are responsible for security requirements and posting signs regarding the restricted areas for which they are responsible according to AR 190-13, paragraph 2-10.

**Significance** Every person and vehicle entering restricted areas is subject to search.

- Unauthorized entry is prohibited.
  - Photographing, making notes, drawings, maps, or graphic representations of these areas or their activities is prohibited unless specifically authorized by the Commander.
  - Any such materials found in the possession of unauthorized personnel are confiscated.
