Purpose This regulation provides guidance, procedures, and policies for

- reporting recurring Weekly Religious Activities Report, and
- maintaining statistical data to keep local commanders and higher headquarters apprised of the effectiveness of the current religious program.

Applicability Policies and procedures contained in this regulation apply to

- chaplains assigned or attached to Fort Hood, and
- religious activities conducted on the installation.

General Actual performance report is submitted weekly

- by 1200 each Tuesday
- on FORSCOM Form 379-R (Religious Activities Report).

1c

FORSCOM Form 379-R Procure FORSCOM Form 379-R through normal AG publication supply channels.

This quarterly report form has been adapted to report weekly activities' statistics by using only sections A-D.

Use a separate form for each report.

Quarterly Evaluation The Quarterly Program Evaluation (FORSCOM Form 379-R, section E and section F) is submitted

- by close of business (COB)
- on the 5th working day after the end of each quarter
- by major subordinate command (MSC) chaplains to III Corps and Fort Hood Chaplain's Office.

RESPONSIBILITIES

III Corps and Fort Hood Chaplain The Chaplain, III Corps and Fort Hood

- collects and maintains Fort Hood statistics
- informs the Commanding General on chaplain program effectiveness, and
- submits quarterly report to FORSCOM Chaplain.

Chaplains

MSC Chaplains

- consolidate weekly statistics
- provide evaluations of two programs conducted within the quarter
- evaluate the total religious program within the command, and
- submit weekly and quarterly reports to III Corps and Fort Hood Chaplain's Office.
