MEMORANDUM FOR SFF DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Computer Network Security

1. REFERENCE.

- a. AR 21-1, Army Information Management, 31 May 02.
- b. AR 25 2, Information Assurance, 14 Nov 03.

2. APPLICABILITY. This policy applies to III Corps and all subordinate commands and organizations/activities that utilize computer systems on the Fort Hood network.

3. POLICY. In order to assure security of the Fort Hood network, commanders, senior executives, and managers are to comply with the following policies:

- a. All Installation Local Area Network (ILAN) users must log onto the Fort Hood domain.
- b. All network workstations will comply with Department of the Army published Information Assurance Vulnerability Alert (IAVA) directives and network security procedures.
- c. Failure to follow any of the above procedures and proper security policies for accessing an Internet/Intranet web site(s) will result in immediate suspension of network access and privileges until compliance is confirmed.
- d. Telephone and ILAN subscribers are responsible for the proper use of equipment. Under no circumstances will a subscriber move, alter, place an attachment on, or make any additions to official telephone or ILAN equipment, to include, but not limited to, hubs, routers, switches, and any multi-port devices.
- e. The Directorate of Information Management will:
 - (1) Establish standardized patch management policies, procedures, and tools.

(2) Maintain a network security web page on <http://www.hood.army.mil/doim/ia> where the latest notices, patches, updates, and service packs will be located for easy access.

(3) Proactively monitor the network for new vulnerabilities and patches for all software identified in the system.

(4) Conduct risk assessments and report findings as required by regulation.

4. EXPIRATION. This Phantom Six Command Policy Memorandum will remain in effect until superseded or rescinded.
