Local Calling Areas

Extended Area Service (EAS) and Expanded Local Calling (ELC) allow Fort Hood personnel to place free local calls by dialing the appropriate seven-digit number. When calling from Fort Hood (254 Area Code), the following cities are included in the EAS and ELC programs:

EAS: Copperas Cove, Fort Hood, Harker Heights, Killeen, Nolanville

ELC: Flat, Gatesville, Jarrell (512), Kempner (512)

To call EAS numbers, users must dial 9 + seven-digit number (ex. 9-xxx-xxxx). To call ELC numbers with a 512 Area Code, users must dial 9 + 512 + seven-digit number (ex. 9-512-xxx-xxxx). For more information, please contact Ms. Sara Holt at 287-7089.

The following DSN prefixes are established for incoming DSN calls to Fort Hood only. Do not use 88 + DSN prefix to make an on-post call (ex. 88-737-xxxx).

Fort Hood CALTROP

The Caltrop Bulletin is the III Corps command information bulletin that is published once per week. The DOIM publishes and authenticates the Caltrop bulletin using the III Corps and Fort Hood seal. The Caltrop Bulletin contains advisory, directional, and informational (official and unofficial) items that are published on a temporary basis.

Official items include those items that are advisory, informative, or directive in nature, such as orders of the command or agency, training notices, newly revised forms and publications, and settlements of estates.

Unofficial information includes information such as intramural sporting events, MWR activities, office closures, memorial visits to Fort Hood cemeteries, changes of command, road closures, or announcements regarding medical services available to Fort Hood Soldiers.
