

Clearing Standards Summary for Environmental Compliance

1. The following Best Management Practices shall always be employed:
 - a. Recycle using appropriate recycle containers. For special recycle pickups, such as scrap metal, large amounts of cardboard or pallets, contact Recycle Center at 287-1606.
 - b. Avoid illegal disposal of prohibited items into recycle or trash dumpsters. Additional refuse containers can be scheduled by calling 287-1054 or 287.9184.
 - c. Use drip pads/pans where fluids might leak.
 - d. Respond to spills immediately and call Fire and Emergency Services, 287-3908 for specific guidance on spill cleanup.

2. The following shall be accomplished prior to clearing the facility:
 - a. Serviceable items, i.e. Class III (P), hazardous materials, cleaning products, and unused other products, shall be turned in using existing supply procedures. The DPW Classification Unit does not accept serviceable items. Contact your chain of command for turn-in procedures.
 - b. Used, partially used, unwanted, and unserviceable items, shall be turned in to the DPW-Classification Unit. Call for instructions and appointment, 288-7627
 - c. Household Products (cleaners, solvents, pesticides, etc.) may be turned in to the Household Hazardous Materials Collection Center. Call 288-7627 for further information.
 - d. Parts washers are installation property book items and are not to be removed from the facility. Call 288-5264 for service or removal.
 - e. Work orders submitted for all water leaks.
 - f. Used Product Reclamation Point cleared and clean.
 - g. Used product above ground storage tanks are empty, call 286-5993 for service.
 - h. Wash racks and oil-water separators cleaned and trash removed. Contaminated soil delivered to BioSite, call 286-5993 for appointment or to schedule oil-water separator service.
 - i. Contact DPW-ENV, Environmental Compliance Assessment Team (ECAT) for closeout briefing and current clearance checklist which includes requirements not specifically listed in this summary.

3. Compliance Assessments will be conducted as part of the clearing process. Deficiencies will be documented and provided to the Rear Detachment Commander for resolution.
