Dear Mr. Bodkin:

This is in response to your exemption registration, Form PI-7, concerning the construction of a paint spray booth in Building 4273 at Fort Hood.

After evaluation of the information which you have furnished, we have determined that construction of the booth is exempt from permitting procedures under 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Section 106.433 if constructed and operated as described in your registration request. This exemption was authorized by the Executive Director of the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) pursuant to 30 TAC Chapter 106. A copy of the exemption in effect at the time of this registration is enclosed. You must operate in accordance with all requirements of the enclosed exemption.

You are reminded that regardless of whether a permit is required, this facility must be in compliance with all rules and regulations of the TNRCC and of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency at all times.

Also, we understand that the paint booths in Buildings 4483, 4615, and 88036 are no longer operational and you want their registrations voided. Therefore, as of this date Exemption Registration Nos. 24534, 24536, and 24537 are voided.


