

Accessing Fort Hood for Friday Night Football

The Killeen Independent School District will play the first football game at the new Fort Hood Stadium at 7:30 p.m., Friday.

The game will be between the Harker Heights Knights and Shoemaker Greywolves.

A release Tuesday by KISD provided procedures for spectators wishing to attend the game on the military installation.

Spectators driving privately-owned vehicles must enter and exit the installation through the Clear Creek Gate.

The driver and each passenger must have identification (driver's license, passport or state-issued ID). An adult can vouch for anyone under 18 years of age.

Fort Hood personnel and traffic signs will direct spectators/traffic to the stadium.

Spectators allowed installation access will travel the most direct route to and from the game site and will not be authorized to travel on other areas of the installation.

No concealed handguns are allowed on the installation.

Handicapped parking will be available and the stadium has handicapped accessible seating.

For those dropping off students/spectators for the game, there is NO direct drop off at the stadium. Drop off will be at the Fort Hood Commissary located on Clear Creek Road. A KISD school bus will shuttle dropped off student/spectators to the stadium and back to the Commissary parking lot every 15 minutes before, during, and after the game.

The Clear Creek Commissary parking lot will also be used for overflow parking and shuttle service will be available.
