SUBJECT: Wear of Reflectorized Vests for Physical Training on Fort Hood

1. APPLICABILITY. This policy applies to all Fort Hood units and tenant activities on Fort Hood.

2. POLICY.

a. Personnel conducting Physical Training (PT) at anytime on Fort Hood roadways will wear a reflective vest or belt. The reflective vest or belt must be worn over the PT uniform. This requirement also applies to civilians and visitors residing in VIP/Guest quarters who run on the installation. This policy supplements current policy in FH Regulation 190-5, Fort Hood Traffic Code, 1 February 1993.

b. Units are responsible for the funding and procurement of additional and replacement vests or belts for their personnel.

c. Reflective devices have proved to be an effective control measure to enhance runner safety during daylight as well as periods of low visibility. When used properly, I feel confident that reflective vests provide needed protection for our Soldiers and civilians while running and/or conducting PT on Fort Hood.

3. EXPIRATION. This Fort Hood Command Policy Memorandum will remain in effect until superseded or rescinded.
