



Todd Fox graduated from the United States Military Academy and was commissioned as an Armor officer in 1994. He initially served as a Tank Platoon Leader in D/1-64 AR and the battalion Scout Platoon Leader at Fort Stewart, GA. CPT Fox commanded C/3-8 CAV and F Troop, 9th CAV before moving to the 1st Cavalry Division staff at Fort Hood, Texas to deploy to Iraq in support of OIF II. After attending the Command and General Staff College at the US Naval War College in Newport, RI, MAJ Fox returned to Fort Hood to serve as the 1st Brigade Combat Team planner and as the Operations Officer for 2-8 CAV in Iraq during OIF 06-08. Upon redeployment, MAJ Fox served on the Army Staff in Washington, DC. In 2011 LTC Fox was assigned to Schofield Barracks, Hawaii to command 1-27 IN (Stryker). After completing the US Army War College in Carlisle Barracks, PA, COL Fox deployed to Camp Lemonnier, Djibouti where he served as Director, CJ-3/5/7 for the Combined Joint Task Force-Horn of Africa. COL Fox's last assignment was as the Commander, US Army Garrison, Fort Hood, Texas from 2015-2017.

COL Fox holds a Master of Arts in National Security and Strategic Studies from the US Naval War College in Newport, RI; a Masters of Policy Management from Georgetown University in Washington, DC; and a Master of Arts in Strategic Studies from the US Army War College in Carlisle, PA.

COL Fox's awards and decorations include the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star Medal with oak leaf cluster, the Purple Heart, the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal with 4 oak leaf clusters, the Ranger Tab, Parachutist Badge, Air Assault Badge, Combat Action Badge, and the Army Staff Identification Badge.
