MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Robert Gray Army Airfield (RGAAF) Deployment Operations

1. **APPLICABILITY.** This policy applies to all Fort Hood personnel.
2. **POLICY.** RGAAF is classified as a Restricted Area. As a Restricted Area, access is restricted to mission essential personnel only. Additionally, RGAAF is classified as a Category 1 Power Projection Airfield, serving multiple air carriers and providing all aircraft and ground services one would expect from an international airport. To ensure the safety, security, and operational efficiency of the RGAAF Power Projection mission the following requirements are in effect:
 - a. Family Members and friends of deploying/re-deploying personnel are not authorized access to the Larkin Terminal area during deployment/re-deployment operations. Other civilian personnel must be authorized in advance by the Airfield Manager.
 - b. A maximum of five personnel from the unit Chain of Command are authorized on the South Ramp to farewell/welcome unit personnel plane-side. These personnel will be escorted at all times while on the South Ramp.
 - c. Only personnel with tasks directly related to the deployment/re-deployment missions will be permitted access to the Larkin Terminal area during deployment/re-deployment operations.
 - d. Personnel requiring access to the Larkin Terminal area during deployment/re-deployment operations must be either be issued an Airfield Access Badge or listed on a Unit Access Roster maintained at Entry Control Point (ECP) 54. Personnel not issued an Airfield Access Badge or listed on a unit access roster will be denied access. The point of contact for access badges and access rosters is the Airfield Manager.
 - e. Limited vehicle parking is available in the vicinity of the Larkin Terminal. The number of vehicles in the vicinity of the terminal will be limited to the greatest extent possible by the utilization of vans, buses, tactical vehicles, and/or car-pooling. The use of personally owned vehicles will be minimized to the greatest extent possible. Over-flow vehicle parking is available on Clarke Road in the vicinity of Building 90145.

SUBJECT: Robert Gray Army Airfield (RGAAF) Deployment Operations

f. Media personnel and photographers are not authorized on the South Ramp or in the vicinity of the Larkin Terminal without prior coordination with the Airfield Manager. Media personnel and photographers must be approved by either the III Corps or Division Public Affairs Office (PAO) and will be escorted at all times while on the South Ramp. All photographs on the South Ramp will be tight shots of deploying/re-deploying personnel only. Photographs of RGAAF, airline names/logos, and aircraft tail numbers are strictly prohibited.

3. EXPIRATION. This Fort Hood Command Policy Memorandum will remain in effect until superseded or rescinded.
