

III Corp Aviation Safety & Standardization Bulletin 17-01

SUBJECT: Mixing of lighted and unlighted aircraft.

1. Background: IAW TC 3-04.81 (FM 3-04.303), dated October 2010, Section III – Airspace Information Center Operations; Responsibilities, para 2-44, requires procedures to preclude the mixing of lighted and unlighted aircraft. Although “Blackout” operations are addressed in FH 95-1 dated 9 May 16, FH 95-1 does not specifically state mixing of lighted and unlighted aircraft is not authorized.

2. Change FH 95-1 dated 9 May 16 to read as follows:

a. Change para. 5-16g to read:

WTA Blackout operations will be IAW FAA Exemption 9835 to 14CFR 91.209(a) (1) and (2). See Appendix B of this regulation


b. Change para. 5-16g(1) to read:

FHRTA Blackout operations will only be conducted within an active ROZ.

c. Change para. 5-16g(5) to read:

Mixing of lighted and unlighted aircraft is not authorized. One fully lighted, non-tactical aircraft (high bird) will be dedicated to over watch scheduled airspace ROZ in the immediate vicinity of the blackout operations to preclude the mixing of lighted and unlighted aircraft. The high bird will: See FH 95-1 para 5 (a)
